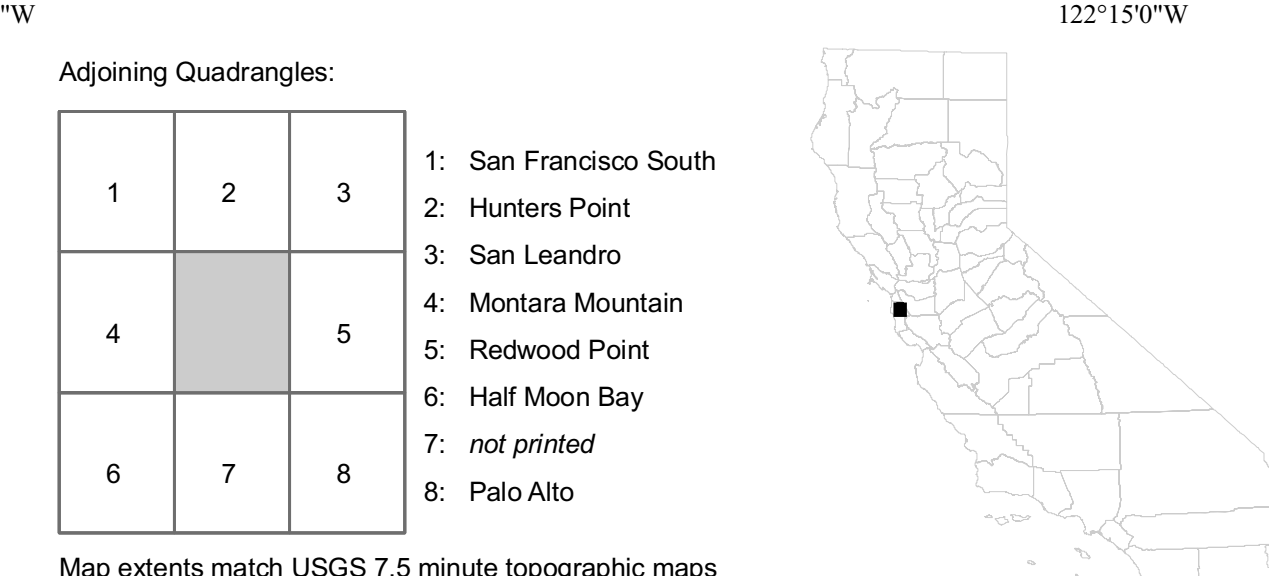
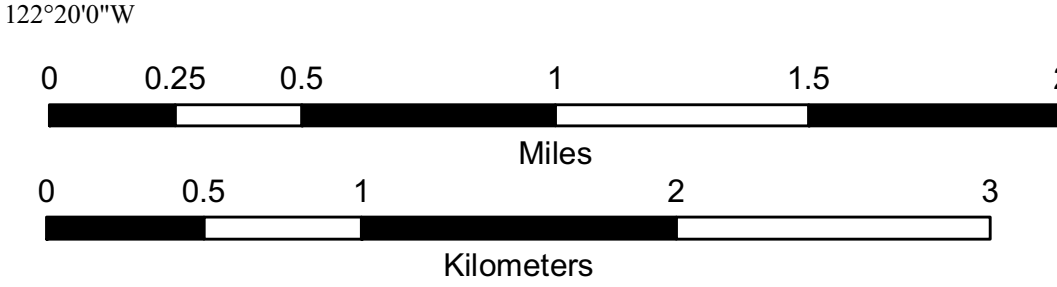
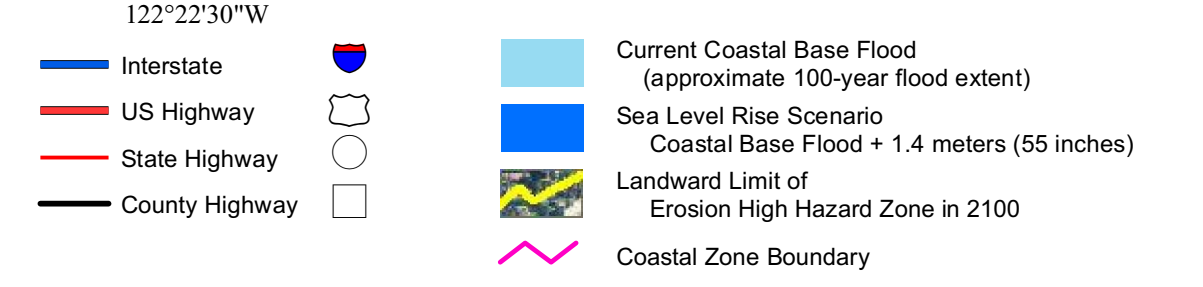
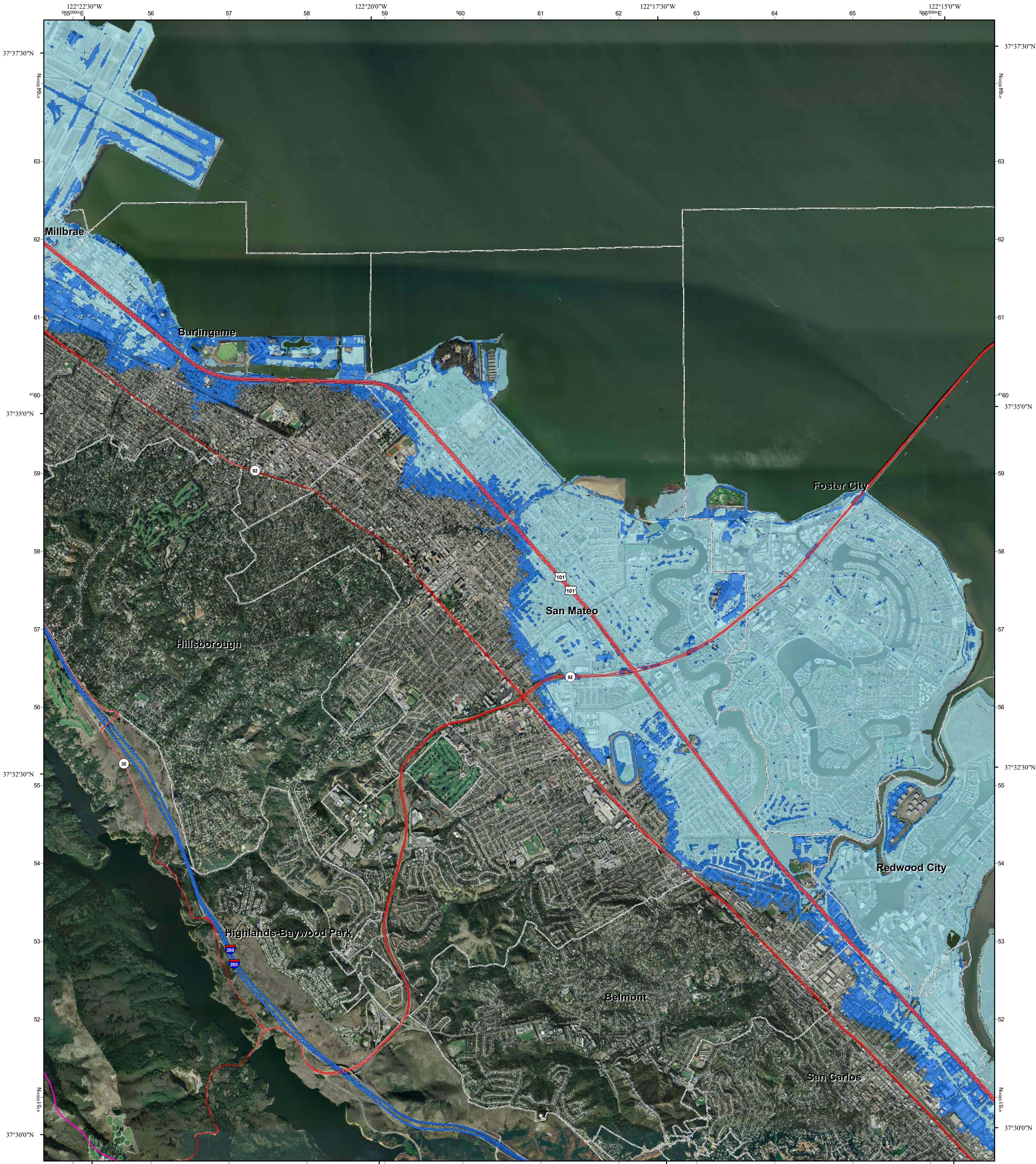


California Flood Risk: Sea Level Rise San Mateo Quadrangle
